Position Background

This is an **appointed**, non-paid (volunteer) zone position serving until **December 31, 2012** on the Marion Soil and Water Conservation District's Board of Directors. The actual term of this position expires December 31, 2014. Qualified individuals may then run for election for this position in the November 2012 general election in order to serve out the remainder of the term.

Two options are available to an individual for the zone director requirements:

Option #1:

1. Own or manage 10 or more acres of land in the district.
 - a. Reside within the zone that is represented; **or**
 - b. Own or manage 10 or more acres within the zone that is being represented.
2. Be involved in the active management of the property; and
3. Reside within the boundaries of the district; and
4. Be a registered voter.

Option #2:

1. Reside within the zone that is represented; and
2. Has served at least one year as a director or associate director of a soil and water district; and
3. Has a conservation plan approved by the district board; and
4. Be a registered voter.

The Zone 2 area encompasses the land east of I-5 to the Deschutes County line except for small area in Woodburn which follows the railroad tracks and is east of Hwy. 99, then west of Hwy. 213 and north starting below the town of Brooks to the Clackamas County line. The towns that are included in Zone 2 are Brooks, Gervais, Mt Angel, Hubbard, Aurora and most of Woodburn.
