IDENTIFICATION

A somewhat succulent annual with red-spotted orange flowers with recurved spurs. Elliptic to egg-shaped, alternate, scalloped leaves.

IMPACTS

Forms a dense carpet, particularly in riparian understories and shades out native plants. Die by fall, leading to soil erosion.

MANAGEMENT

Hand pull small patches when soils are moist. Repeat annually until seed bank has been depleted. Bag and seal seed capsules, if present.
