



PARROTFEATHER

Myriophyllum aquaticum



IDENTIFICATION

An aquatic floating plant. Between May-Oct. spikes of feathery leaves emerge up to 1' above the water.

IMPACTS

Clogs waterways, ponds, and ditches. Eliminates native plants, aquatic habitat, and recreation.

MANAGEMENT

Can be pulled or raked, being careful to completely remove all fragments. Herbicide only by licensed applicator.
